If	I won the lottery,	I would buy a new house

RESULT	IF	CONDITION
WOULD+BASE VERB		PAST SIMPLE
I would buy a new house	if	I won the Christmas lottery

IF - CLAUSE (Condition)	MAIN - CLAUSE (Result)
If I won a million dollars, 	I would buy a new car. 
If I studied hard, 	I would pass the exam. 
If I were the president, 	I would lower taxes
